Coláiste UISCE policy statement regarding Children and Sport.
(The Code of ethics Good Practise for Children's Sport - Irish Sports Council 2001)

We encourage a positive Irish learning atmosphere in Colaiste UISCE. We respect each others rights and place emphasis on creating a safe learning environment. We therefore expect all students to conduct themselves in a positive, well mannered and co-operative manner. In order to maintain the positive safe learning environment outlined in our policy statement, the following primary rules are necessary. Students will be advised of other house rules on arrival.

RIAIL NA GAELIGE / The Irish Rule

Caithfidh gach duine iarracht a dhéanamh Gaeilge a labhairt i gcónaí.

Students must make a determined effort to speak Irish at all times. This is made easy by the individual attention and help they receive from our instructors and bean an tí's. Repetitive non compliance to this rule will result in dismissal from Coláiste UISCE.

RIALACHA EILE / Other Rules

1. Any form of bullying or abusive behaviour to other students or staff will not be tolerated.
2. Students are not allowed to go swimming or onto the beach without supervision.
3. Students are not permitted to leave their accommodation between supper time and breakfast time the following morning or leave the environs of the Coláiste during the course.
4. Students are not permitted to consume or be in possession of alcohol or any other form of prohibited substance, or enter licensed premises during the course.
5. Smoking is not permitted on the course.

PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Children are not permitted to take photos in the changing room or bedroom areas or upload any pictures from UISCE onto the internet – this includes sites such as facebook, snapchat and instagram specifically.

In accordance with the Code of Ethics and Good Practice in children's sport Coláiste UISCE wishes to advise parents that photos may be taken of your child during activities.
